



Pairing Process

Moseley for Ukraine

Overview



Moseley for Ukraine is a volunteer organisation based in Moseley, Birmingham.

We aim to facilitate pairing between Ukrainian displaced persons (refugees) and families willing to participate in sponsoring under the Government scheme “homes for Ukraine”.

We are not qualified immigration experts, but we will introduce you to each other, including translations if necessary, help through the process of being a sponsor try to answer any questions.



Moseley for Ukraine has been engaging with refugees through word of mouth contacts of Ukrainians in and around Moseley as well as through direct communication via social media channels. Whilst we facilitate the pairing of hosts and refugees, we can not vouch for our refugees. Checks are conducted by the UK government and we asks hosts and refugees to ensure that in their initial communication set up by Moseley for Ukraine both parties are comfortable with each other.

Once you have decided to you would like to offer accomodation as a host, please follow the process outlined below to ensure we can facilitate you with a possible pairing of a refugee family or individual

1. Please register your interest in being a host by filling out this form: [HOSTING | Moseley for Ukraine](#)
2. The team will then work to identify a Ukrainian family or individual that could be paired to you and fits within the available accommodation of your home. We will share with you the nature of the family and some background details.
3. You will receive a call from us about a prospective pairing and if you feel that it sounds suitable and give your permission, we will create a whatsapp group with your prospective family/ individual and a Ukrainian / Russian language translator if required to ensure the discussion is understood on both sides. In meeting each other, you will be able to fully explore the prospective hosting opportunity.
4. If both parties agree to proceed with the hosting, then you and the family can move forward to complete the UK Visa Application Process which is the formal step for registration under the UK Government Homes for Ukraine Scheme. This process involves both parties and is outlined in detail on our website [HOSTING | Moseley for Ukraine](#)
5. The Homes for Ukraine scheme allows residency for 6 months minimum in your home, with the right to remain and work in the UK for up to 3 years.
6. Visa Approval: this can take several weeks. In the meantime, we ask encourage you to continue engaging with your refugee family / individual and to understand the needs of your family for when they arrive in the UK. This could include discussions on schooling, elderly care, medical care, jobs, university studies, pet care etc.
7. Visa granted: Now your Ukrainian family / Individual will need to organise travel to the UK and a date / location of their arrival. Please offer to help organise this if you are able to. We would advise where at all possible, that you meet your Ukrainian family at the travel hub when they arrive.
8. Arrival in the UK: There may be immediate needs that will need your help in organising. Please continue to use the website [HOME | Moseley for Ukraine](#) and the support and resources being made available for Ukrainians in Moseley to ensure your family/ individual is able to settle in as well as possible.
